



Thank you for contacting us.

As you probably already know, our data come from Scopus, they annually send us an update of the data. This update is sent to us around April / May every year.

The calculation of the indicators is performed with the copy of the Scopus database provided to us annually. However, the methodology used (concerning the distribution by Quartiles) by Scopus is different from the one used by SCImago, even if, since the past year, the scientometrics indicators' calculation procedure changed in order to resemble SciVal.

For every journal, the annual value of the SJR is integrated into the distribution of SJR values of all the subject categories to which the journal belongs. The distribution by Quartiles cannot be considered over the journals' total amount within a Category. In the case of SCImago, the distribution has to be considered with the formula Highest-SJR minus Lowest-SJR divided into four.
